BPI-Philam Odyssey Asia Pacific High Dividend Equity Fund Market Commentary

Asian equities ended the month up in July for the second consecutive month. A rising optimism for policy stimulus in China after the Politburo meeting and the FOMC's less hawkish tilt indicating a likely end of the rate hike cycle helped markets. The US 10-year treasury yield ended higher. The Politburo meeting towards the end of the month outlined stimulus for consumption and housing raising investor's expectations for economic recovery. The MSCI Asia Pacific ex-Japan Net Index returned 5.8% for the month, with value outperforming growth. Asian markets ended the month in the green. China, Singapore and Thailand gained the most, while Indonesia, Taiwan and Philippines gained the least.


